## SIGN CHECKLIST

THIS DOCUMENT IS PROVIDED AS A GUIDE FOR CUSTOMERS TO BE AWARE OF THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT FOR AND OBTAIN A PERMIT. THIS IS ONLY A GUIDE AS OTHER DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION MAY BE REQUIRED.

- 1. Applications with Notarized signatures of qualifier of contractor or owner builder.
- 2. Complete Notarized Owner/Builder Affidavit if owner is acting as contractor per FS 489 exemption.
- 3. <u>Proof of Ownership</u> i.e. PBC Property Appraiser cover sheet, Homestead Exemption or Warranty Deed.
- 4. Copy of recorded Notice of Commencement if over \$2500 in value.
- 5. Electrical Application with registered contractor required with submittal (if applicable).
- 6. <u>Property Site Plan or Survey</u> legible and scaled to 1/8 = 1-foot or greater with the following minimum requirements:
  - A. Printed legal description.
  - B. Property address and Date on all pages.
  - C. Location of all proposed Monument or Directional signage.
  - D. Location of building elevation of proposed sign installation.
  - E. All property lines and easements.
  - F. Setbacks from all existing and proposed structures.
  - G. All streets bounding the property.
- 7. <u>Construction/Design Plans</u> legible and scaled to 1/8 = 1-foot or greater meeting the following minimum requirements:
  - A. Property Address and Date on all pages.
  - B. Engineered Product Approvals and or Engineered Plans for signs over 10' in height.
  - C. Foundation and Anchoring detail.
  - D. Scaled size of sign to include ALL length, width and height dimensions.
  - E. <u>Scaled design of sign face</u> to include <u>text and logos with colors</u> of all components.
  - F. <u>Scaled Elevation of proposed location</u> with all length, width and height dimensions.
  - G. Note that states structure complies with FBC current 170 mph wind speed.
  - H. Fastener attachment details.
  - I. Signs shall not obstruct any Fire or Emergency access.
  - J. Electrical signs shall include wire size and circuit breaker and or disconnect of existing and proposed construction.

NOTE: The Village of Royal Palm Beach reserves the right to require additional information and or documentation as deemed necessary to complete the review and permitting process per Florida Statute 553.79.
