2. Describe how this evaluation report was prepared and how it was submitted to the governing body, released to the media, and made available to the public:

This evaluation report was prepared by the CRS coordinator with input from Engineering and Public Works staff regarding future project and needs.

The status of all mitigation projects and success stories are reported and discussed at LMS General Meetings and through periodic briefings to the LMS Steering Committee. All general meetings are publicized through media releases and posted announcements.

The status of the Village’s flood mitigation projects and general Capital Improvement Projects are discussed in the Village’s budget meeting hearings which are publicly held.

The report was sent to the Village Mayor and Council on April 27, 2023 via a memo and has been made available to the media and public on the Village’s website.

3. Provide a description of the implementation of each recommendation or action item in the action plan or area analysis report, including a statement on how the project was implemented or not implemented during the previous year:

There are 95 projects on the on the *LMS Project Prioritized List (PPL)* dated Fall 2022. The Village of Royal Palm Beach has 3 projects on the list ranked 40, 44, and 81:

The Bridge Slope Stabilization Project is a Capital Improvement Project in the FY 2022-2024 Capital Improvement Plan. Four of 16 bridges have been completed and stabilization projects for four additional bridges have been designed and going to bid Summer 2023.

4. Discuss why any objectives were not reached or why implementation is behind schedule:

The Village of Royal Palm Beach is on track with budgeting and constructing FMP related projects.

5. What are the recommendations for new projects or revised recommendations?

Additional projects are being reviewed for improved drainage canal debris removal techniques and possible additional storage.
