SAVE MONEY ON FLOOD INSURANCE

On October 1, 2018, the Village of Royal Palm Beach was accepted into the FEMA Community Rating System (CRS) program with a Class 6 rating. The Class 6 rating will allow Village residents who are in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) to receive a 20% discount on their flood insurance premiums. Residents not in the SFHA who wish to purchase flood insurance can receive a 10% discount. The CRS is a voluntary program for communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The CRS offers flood insurance policy premium discounts in communities that develop and execute extra measures beyond minimum floodplain management requirements to provide protection from flooding.

Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for the Village, to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area and if it may be affected by local drainage problems. It will also show if the property is in an area that has previously had flooding problems or is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions.

Know How to Protect Your Property

There are practical and cost effective methods for reducing or eliminating your property's exposure to flooding.

- Electrical panel boxes, A/C condensing units and other appliances should be elevated above ground level.
- Check your building for water entry points such as doors, low windows and dryer vents.

• Dry flood proofing includes sealing or waterproofing with special materials and compounds which provide a chemical or physical barrier against water intrusion during times of flooding.

• Search the Palm Beach County library catalog for "Flood" information. Go to FEMA's website <u>www.ready.gov/floods</u>. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property. Call the Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for advice.

Flood Warning

Understand our local alert notification systems and prepare to take actions to protect yourself and your property when flooding is imminent. Residents should be aware that Royal Palm Beach is directed by Palm Beach County Emergency Management Division who advises our community of impending storms and flood threats. For more information about emergency notification, go to the Palm Beach County website at www.pbcgov.com. You will be notified of flood watches (when conditions are likely for flooding) and warnings (flooding is imminent) by local television and radio stations. You should also monitor the Weather Channel and have a NOAA weather radio on-hand with extra batteries.

• No construction, including the moving of earth, is allowed in the floodplain without a permit.

• Always check with the Village before you alter, re-grade or bring fill onto your property to make sure you don't cause drainage problems for you or your neighbors.

You need to know that you can take steps to protect your financial security before disaster strikes. However, many residents and businesses are unaware that they qualify for flood insurance or that policies are more affordable than they may think.

The following are important facts and figures for residents so that they better understand the risk of flooding, its impact and how flood insurance can help reduce the financial impact of flooding. There is usually a 30-day waiting period for flood insurance to take effect. More than 20 percent of all flood claims are for properties located outside of high-risk flood areas. Federal disaster assistance is usually provided in the form of a loan that must be paid back with interest along with any existing mortgage.

Property owners, renters and business owners in the Village of Royal Palm Beach can purchase flood insurance on their buildings and contents. Call your insurance agent today, go to <u>www.FloodSmart.gov</u> or call (800) 427-4661 to find an agent and to find out more about protecting your property from rising waters. You should consider the purchase of flood insurance whether your property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area or not. Renters should buy flood insurance for their belongings.

You can call the Village of Royal Palm Beach for flood insurance advice at (561) 790-2612.

News from Captain Ulrich Naujoks - PBSO

If you own a firearm, please be responsible and do not leave it your vehicle. Firearms should be secured at all times. Since January 1, 2018, there have been twenty three vehicle burglaries in the Village of Royal Palm Beach wherein firearms were stolen. Of those vehicle burglaries, nineteen vehicles were left unlocked with unsecured weapons stolen.

Please help yourself and do what you can to prevent victimization. Prevention is the simplest and most costeffective way to thwart would-be thieves. As such, I recommend the following:

- Lock your vehicle.
- Take your spare keys with you. Nearly 80% of all vehicles stolen in the Village had keys in them. (They were vehicle burglaries that turned into vehicle thefts when the keys were found)
- Park in well-lighted areas. (Most vehicle thefts and vehicle burglaries occur at night.)
- When possible, park in attended lots. (Burglars and car thieves do not like witnesses.)
- Do not leave your vehicle unattended and running.
- Close all windows.
- Do not leave valuables in plain view.
- Do not leave firearms in vehicle.

- If you have a garage, use it when possible. When you do, lock both the vehicle and the garage.
- Garage door opener avoid leaving them in your vehicle. If the suspects find one, they may use it to enter your home, even if they return later to do so.

In the event you have the misfortune of becoming the victim of a vehicle burglary:

- Do not touch anything or enter the vehicle.
- Call the Sheriff's Office immediately at (561) 688-3400.
- If the suspect is still there DO NOT confront them CALL 911.

When reporting the incident, try to give the communications officer as much information as possible. They will ask you a number of questions. The more information they have, the better our chances of catching the suspect. If a key to your vehicle was taken, contact a locksmith or your vehicle service center immediately. Please note - thieves have stolen keys and have returned to steal the vehicle at a later time.
