

Royal Palm Hires New Parks & Recreation Director

Director. Mark Pawlowski (Aurora, IL) will follow the successful leadership of Lou Recchio who retired from the position in late October. Pawlowski comes to the Village of Royal Palm Beach with more than 20+ year of experience as the Executive Director at the Winfield Park District. Under his leadership at the Winfield Park District he has secured more than \$4.1mil in grants to enhance the parks and facilities of their District. He currently manages 18 active park sites that include playgrounds, athletic fields, natural areas, riverfront sites (with canoe/kayak launch), a museum, a splash pad, and numerous trails & shelters. His District area also includes 500+ acres of open space that is managed by the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County. Pawlowski stated "My current District is a near match to the programs and activities offered by the Village of Royal Palm Beach. The only exception is the tremendous asset that is Commons Park, which is unmatched by almost every community."

"I am very much aware of the high level of service, parks and facilities the Lou has built and maintained for the Royal Palm Beach community and I plan to continue those efforts with the team that is in the Parks and Recreation Department and on the Recreation Advisory Board," continued Pawolwski. Pawlowski comes to the Village with a strong background of park site management, athletic field and facility maintenance, and construction. He most recently completed a \$5.6 mil remodeling and expansion of the 30,000sq.ft. C.R.Beggs Activity Center. This experience will be very useful as the Village of Royal Palm Beach nears the expansion of their Recreation Center.

Moving to southeast Florida will not be a completely new experience for Mark and his wife Amy, as their two children both have lived and worked in the Miami area for the past few years. "My son graduated from FIU-Miami a few years ago and I had always hoped to be able to continue my career in south Florida. Royal Palm Beach is known as a community that really supports and uses their parks and recreation offerings. I'm excited to get started in early December and become part of that community. The Village of Royal Palm Beach looks very similar to the communities I have lived and worked in for several years. I have a comfort level in establishing relationships in a much larger city like Aurora (pop. 180,000-200,000) where I reside, as well as smaller villages like Winfield (pop. 11,000-20,000)," continued Pawlowski. In his downtime, Pawlowski enjoys coaching high school girls' basketball, golfing on the weekends, and playing pickle ball with his wife.
