Engineering Updates

PWXXRR – Road Resurfacing

- Road work is wrapping up in Phases 1 and 9 (excluding Royal Palm Beach Blvd.), and beginning in Phase 2.
- Curb and sidewalk work for Phases 5 and 6.
- This large-scale road and sidewalk project will continue through summer 2026.

PW2204 – La Mancha Subdivision Underdrain

- Approximately 60% complete, and is estimated to be finished in early Spring 2026

SW2504 – La Mancha Ave Drainage

- Contractor has been brought on board, and work should begin in late Fall 2025
