
Finance Updates

Popular Annual Financial Report





Engineering Updates

PW22RR – Road Resurfacing

Last week, the Bid Opening took place, with multiple contractors submitting their proposals. Over the next month, they will gather information, ask questions, and finalize their plans. In addition to resurfacing the roads, the project includes significant upgrades to curbs and curb ramps, ensuring necessary repairs and ADA compliance for improved accessibility. The winning bid will be confirmed at the next Council meeting.



Culture Center Porte Cochere

This project is nearing its start, with construction expected to begin in early spring. As part of the improvements, a new covered entry structure will be built at the main entrance of the Cultural Center. This addition is designed to provide a convenient and sheltered area for drop-off and pick-up, ensuring that visitors can stay protected from the elements while accessing the facility.



La Mancha Subdivision Underdrain

This project is getting ready to begin, with construction expected to start in early spring. As part of the work, underdrain systems will be installed beneath the edges of the roadway to protect the road base from groundwater intrusion. Additionally, all roads within the project area will be resurfaced to ensure a smoother and more durable driving experience.




