# Community Development

## Ordinance 1068: Supporting Safe Coexistence With Wildlife

The Village of Royal Palm Beach recently adopted **Ordinance 1068**, strengthening guidelines that help residents and wildlife live together safely and respectfully. This update responds to growing concerns about wildlife feeding, nuisance behavior, and impacts on neighborhood quality of life.

The ordinance:

- Clarifies nuisance behaviors that may affect neighbors or property
- Discourages feeding wildlife in ways that cause dependency or conflict
- Aligns with county policies and includes a fair, evidence-based enforcement process

Protects residents, property values, and the wellbeing of animals

Many residents interact with wildlife out of kindness. Ordinance 1068 ensures those good intentions support healthy, natural behaviors while helping maintain peaceful neighborhoods. Together, we can preserve the balance that makes Royal Palm Beach a beautiful, nature-rich place to call home.

## Engineering Updates

### **PWXXRR – Road Resurfacing**

- Restoration work has been completed in Phase 3.
- Base repair work in Phase 5 is nearing completion, with paving to follow.
- Base repair and resurfacing on Barcelona Drive are nearing completion.
- Milling operations have begun on Bilbao Street.
- Milling and paving in Phase 6 are ongoing and are expected to be completed in February.
- Repairs and resurfacing on Wildcat Way are anticipated to begin in March.
- This comprehensive road and sidewalk improvement project is ongoing and will continue through Summer 2026.

### **PW2204 – La Mancha Subdivision Underdrain**

- All underdrain work has been completed. Remaining resurfacing work is anticipated to be finished by early Spring 2026.

### **SW2504 – La Mancha Ave Drainage**

- The contractor began construction in late January.



# News from PBSO District 9

## Bicycle Safety



STOP

LEFT TURN

RIGHT TURN



### BUFFERED BIKE LANE

A buffered bike lane indicates a standard 7' or 6' wide bike lane. The extra line ("buffer" stripe) makes the lane look too narrow for motor vehicles. The lanes are wide enough to provide the 3' minimum passing distance required by law.



### BIKE LANES WITH SOLID LINES

These are for people traveling on bicycles only. Motor vehicle drivers should not cross into these lanes unless they have yielded to bicyclists before turning.



### BIKE LANES WITH DASHED LINES

These give bicyclists a place to ride, but motor vehicle drivers may need to merge into them at certain times. Motor vehicle drivers should yield to bicyclists before crossing the dotted line or making a turn.



### BICYCLE DETECTOR MARKING

The Bicycle Detector Marking indicates where a bicyclist should stop to trigger a traffic signal. Place your bicycle wheels directly over the marking. Be patient! Some signal changes may take 3 minutes or longer!

## Electric Bicycle Safety

### Know Your Traffic Laws:

E-bikes are allowed on "any road, path or way that is open to bicycle travel." This means they can be ridden on roads (except limited access highways), bike lanes, bike paths, multi-use paths, and sidewalks. E-bikes must follow all traffic laws including riding with traffic and obeying traffic signals.

### Protect Yourself:

Always wear a helmet regardless of your age. The law requires riders under the age of 16 to wear one at all times.

### Control Your Speed and Brake Early:

E-bikes are quick to pick up momentum and can cause severe injury when at high speeds. Give yourself the appropriate amount of time to slow down.

### Be Aware of Traffic and Pedestrians:

The more predictably you ride, the safer you are. Don't weave in and out of traffic. Always be courteous to pedestrians around you.

### Stay Visible:

Know that you are not as visible to drivers as they are to you. Wear bright or reflective clothing and use lights when riding in low-light conditions or at night.
