Community Development

Ordinance 1068: Supporting Safe Coexistence With Wildlife

The Village of Royal Palm Beach recently adopted **Ordinance 1068**, strengthening guidelines that help residents and wildlife live together safely and respectfully. This update responds to growing concerns about wildlife feeding, nuisance behavior, and impacts on neighborhood quality of life.

The ordinance:

- Clarifies nuisance behaviors that may affect neighbors or property
- Discourages feeding wildlife in ways that cause dependency or conflict
- Aligns with county policies and includes a fair, evidence-based enforcement process

Protects residents, property values, and the wellbeing of animals

Many residents interact with wildlife out of kindness. Ordinance 1068 ensures those good intentions support healthy, natural behaviors while helping maintain peaceful neighborhoods. Together, we can preserve the balance that makes Royal Palm Beach a beautiful, nature-rich place to call home.

Engineering Updates

PWXXRR – Road Resurfacing

- Final striping has been completed in Phases 1–3.
- Milling operations are underway in Phase 5 at Sevilla Avenue and Valencia.
- Final striping at Spanish Pine and Country Club has been completed in Phase 6, and car-detection loops for traffic signals have been replaced.
- Milling, road base rework, and paving in Phase 7 (The Willows) are ongoing.
- Concrete work on Sparrow Drive and Park Road is underway in Phase 8, along with base rework and preliminary repaving at Sycamore, Chestnut, and Nottingham.
- Concrete repairs and final striping have begun in Phase 9 (The Colony).
- Work has commenced on the north end of Royal Palm Beach Boulevard.
- Milling and paving in Phases 5 and 6 are expected to begin soon.
- Concrete repairs and road base work along Royal Palm Beach Boulevard are anticipated in the coming weeks.
- This comprehensive road and sidewalk improvement project is ongoing and will continue through Summer 2026.

PW2204 – La Mancha Subdivision Underdrain

- Milling and road base rework have been completed.
- Final paving and site clean-up are anticipated to be completed in March.

SW2504 – La Mancha Ave Drainage

- Approximately half of the underdrain installation has been completed.
- The remaining underdrain work is expected to be finished in March, with road base rework to follow.

It is an honor to serve this wonderful community as your District Chief with Palm Beach County Fire Rescue. My family and I live in Palm Beach County, and I understand how important it is to feel safe in your home and neighborhood.

Each month, I'll share a simple safety message, a bit of fire service history, and something unique about our Village.

March Safety Message: "Spring Forward" – Check Those Smoke Alarms

As we turn the clocks forward this month, it's the perfect reminder to:

- Change the batteries in your smoke alarms
- Test each alarm in your home
- Review your family's escape plan
- Make sure everyone knows two ways out of every bedroom

Working smoke alarms reduce the risk of dying in a home fire by nearly 50%. It takes less than five minutes to test them — but that small step can make a life-saving difference.

Did You Know?

Home fire deaths in the United States have been cut by more than half since the widespread use of smoke detectors began in the 1970s. It remains one of the most effective life-saving devices ever created.

A Little Royal Palm Beach History

Royal Palm Beach was incorporated in 1959 and was designed as a family-centered community with parks, green spaces, and strong neighborhood connections. Palm Beach County Fire Rescue has provided fire protection in the Village since 1999, helping support the advanced fire and EMS system you rely on today.

DON'T BE A VICTIM OF A SCAMS

Protecting yourself against scams starts with staying informed, cautious, and proactive.

Never share personal or financial information, such as Social Security numbers, bank details, or one-time codes, unless you independently verify the request through a trusted source.

Be skeptical of unsolicited calls, emails, texts, or social media messages, especially those that create urgency, promise guaranteed results, or pressure you to act quickly.

Regularly review bank and credit card statements, monitor your credit report, and use strong, unique passwords for online accounts.

Keep your devices updated with the latest security software, avoid clicking unknown links or attachments, and only conduct financial transactions on secure, encrypted websites.

Most importantly when something doesn't feel right, pause, verify, and report suspicious activity to your financial institution and appropriate authorities, trusting your instincts can prevent costly mistakes.

Consider an educational presentation by our **VAST**, *Volunteers Against Scams Team*, their mission is to advocate and assist citizens of PBC who have been targeted as victims of financial crimes.



