## Village of Royal Palm Beach Village Council Agenda Item Summary

### Agenda Item:

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER APPLICATION NO. 24-016 (AAR), AN APPLICATION BY MARIO LOPEZ PISANI ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH. THE APPLICANT IS REQUESTING ARCHITECTURAL & AESTHETIC REVIEW APPROVAL FOR THE COMMISSION, PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN 11-FOOT TALL SCULPTURAL WORK TITLED "ROOTED" BY ARTIST BETH NYBECK TO FULFILL THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES REQUIREMENT FOR THE NEW VILLAGE HALL, FOR A PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1050 ROYAL PALM BEACH BOULEVARD.

#### Issue:

The Applicant is requesting Architectural & Aesthetic Approval for the commission, purchase and installation of an 11' high, 11.5' wide, and 11.5' deep aluminum sculpture titled "Rooted" by Kansas City based artist Beth Nybeck to fulfill the Art in Public Places requirement for the new Village Hall, for a property located at 1050 Royal Palm Beach Boulevard.

On June 14, 2023, the Village advertised an Open Call to Artists Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) for New Village Hall Public Art Commission in accordance with Section 26-75.5(f)(2)(a)(1) of the Village Code. Following Selection Committee review and ranking, the Village Council awarded a contract to artist Beth Nybeck. The Village entered into an Artist Agreement with Artist Nybeck on December 7, 2023 which contemplates the commissioning of a public art piece to exhibit permanently on the exterior of the new Village Hall, which is broken down into three (3) phases, as follows:

Phase I – Preliminary Rendering

Phase II – Complete Application

Phase III – Commissioning, Creation, and Installation

As part of Phase I, Artist Nybeck conducted one-on-one meetings with all Council members to discuss ideas on the commissioning. Informed by those meetings, Artist Nybeck describes the art piece as follows:

"This dynamic sculpture is built from two intersecting leaves. Nature is such a vital part of Royal Palm Beach. The dedication, pride, and love of your parks was echoed by all council members.

The leaves tower above the viewer at 11' high. When you look at a leaf closely, you can see the veins...the lifeline for water and the pathway for photosynthesis. These vein-

like structures can be found throughout nature—in streams and rivers, our own blood and nervous system, and of course countless botanical examples. It is a picture of life and growth.

Nestled within the water pathway on the leaves are fifty spaces for community responses to be cut out of the surface. There will be an opportunity for the community members of Royal Palm Beach to give reflections on their sense of home. These reflections (one or two words, or a full sentence) will be cut out of the surface of the metal, allowing light and air to pass through their words.

The sculpture embodies the Villages' commitment to preserving nature and parks. It reflects the life, growth, and vibrancy of the community. It celebrates the community's specific ties to their sense of home."

The aluminum sculpture will fulfill the public art requirement as part of Application No. 20-54 (SPM, AAR), as amended with pending Application No. 24-011, approving the site plan modification for the new Village Hall complex. The certified cost estimates for the project were stated as \$12,894,392.00 triggering the Village's Art in Public Places requirement for capital projects equal to one percent (1%) of total vertical construction costs with the costs of art encumbered from Village capital facility budgets not to exceed \$100,000.00 per public facility.

The estimated amount to complete the commission and installation of the aluminum sculpture titled "Rooted" by Artist Beth Nybeck is estimated at \$100,000.00. This project fulfills the Art in Public Places requirement outlined in Sec. 26-75.5. – Art in Public Places under the Village's Code of Ordinances for the new Village Hall.

Note that the Village will install the concrete pad and Code-required lighting for the sculpture.

The Artist anticipates 4-6 months to complete the commissioning once approved, with installation anticipated between August and October 2024.

### **Recommended Action:**

Staff is recommending of Approval of Application No. 24-016 (AAR) with the condition that the Artist provide the Village with engineered wind loads for the proposed piece for permitting purposes. This approval is contingent on Village Council approval of Application No. 24-011 (SPM).



since the applicant meets the review criteria set forth in Section 26-75.5(g) of the Village Code of Ordinances.


