

# VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH

Agenda Item Summary

### **AGENDA ITEM:**

Authorization for the Village Manager to execute a Change Order with Johnson-Davis, Inc. for force main relocation services, not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). All associated costs will be reimbursed by Palm Beach County Water Utilities.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The existing 30-inch storm drain pipe, which has experienced a partial collapse, will be rerouted for a length of approximately 60 linear feet. The new alignment will be situated just north of 1351 Royal Palm Beach Blvd., 33411, near the southwest corner of the bridge.

The Village solicited Requests for Proposals (RFP) on August 19, 2025. Following the solicitation, the Village Council awarded the contract to Johnson-Davis, Inc. in the amount of \$131,810.00 on September 18, 2025.

# **ISSUE:**

A sub-surface utility survey revealed a direct conflict between the existing twelve inch (12.0") sewer force main and the proposed storm drain pipe repairs. To expedite the design and relocation of the sewer force main, thereby allowing the storm drain pipe repair to be completed during the dry season, staff recommends authorizing a change order with Johnson-Davis. The exact value of the change order will be determined after the design is completed and shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

Funding will initially be allocated from the Stormwater Pipe Repair & Replacement project (Project No. SW2502), and subsequently reimbursed in full by Palm Beach County Water Utilities.
