Please transfer \$1,150,000.00 from the 302 fund balance to the proposed Corporate Picnic Pavilion East Project, project number PR2105.

The original corporate pavilion project (PR2308) is funded in the American Rescue Plan account (105). The project scope included two identical pavilions. The South pavilion was part of the base bid and the east pavilion was bid as an add alternate. Due to increases in pavilion square footage and additional underground modifications the bids came in above the project estimate. The effects of Covid-19 have also caused construction costs to rise significantly since the project budget was established. The proposed project will provide funding to construct the east pavilion along with a \$112,000 contingency fund.
