AGENDA ITEM:

APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 22-30 CONFIRMING COUNCIL ACTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 13-32 AND REPLACING IT WITH RESOLUTION NO. 22-30 WHICH IDENTIFIES CERTAIN VILLAGE OWNED PROPERTIES FOR THE PLACEMENT OF TEMPORARY NONCOMMERCIAL SIGNS ASSOCIATED WITH A DEFINITE EVENT. BY VILLAGE CLERK.

ISSUE:

Staff has identified the need to repeal and replace Resolution No. 13-32 to conform with recent revisions to the Village's sign code at Chapter 20. The proposed Resolution No. 22-30 maintains the five (5) Village-owned properties for the placement of temporary noncommercial sign associated with a definite event as provided in Section 20-54 of the Village Code, which include:

- 1. Area located on Village Hall Campus and situated along Okeechobee Boulevard;
- 2. Entrance Sign Right of Way;
- 3. Northwest corner of State Road 7 and Belvedere Road;
- 4. Southwest corner of Folsom Road and Crestwood Boulevard; and
- 5. Northwest corner of Royal Palm Beach Boulevard and Crestwood Boulevard.

RESOLUTION NO. 22-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, SPECIFICALLY REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 13-32 AND ADOPTING A NEW RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF VILLAGE-OWNED LANDS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR TEMPORARY NONCOMMERCIAL SIGN PLACEMENT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 20-54(A)(2) AND SECTION 20-57(8) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Royal Palm Beach, Florida, previously adopted Ordinance No. 1014 on November 18, 2021 in order to modify and update its regulation of signs in order to respond to recent caselaw including *Reed v. Town of Gilbert*, 576 U.S. 155 (2015); and

WHEREA, the Village's updated Sign Code provides for temporary noncommercial signs associated with a definite event to be placed on certain portions of Village-owned property during specific time periods as provided in Section 20-54(a)(2); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1014 specifically provides that the Village Council shall designate by resolution the number and locations on Village-owned lands where such temporary noncommercial signs associated with a definite event may be placed; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Royal Palm Beach, Florida, believes that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens to designate a portion of its traditional "nonpublic forum" property for placement of temporary noncommercial signs associated with a definite event in accordance with Ordinance No. 1014.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: <u>Repeal of Resolution No. 13-32; Adoption of New Resolution</u>. The Village Council of the Village of Royal Palm Beach hereby repeals Resolution No. 13-32 and hereby adopts this Resolution in its place.

<u>Section 2:</u> The Village Council of the Village of Royal Palm Beach hereby designates the locations listed on Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as those portions of Village-owned property that may be utilized for the placement of temporary noncommercial signs associated with a definite event in accordance with Ordinance No. 1014. Placement of such signage shall be limited to one (1) sign per event.

<u>Section 3</u>: Village Staff shall determine the specific area within each designated location that may be utilized for the placement of temporary noncommercial signs associated with a definite event. Village Staff shall clearly mark such allowable areas.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
