Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, and if it may be affected by local drainage problems, or is in an area that has previously had flooding problems, and to see if your property is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property.

- Approved contract with City Electric Supply Company for the supply of LED cobra head fixtures not to exceed \$52,325.00 for the RPB Blvd. N Project.
- Presentation of PBSO District 9 Annual Report.
- Adopted Res. 22-10 approved site plan modification to convert 31,400 SF from Commercial Industrial/Wholesale to Self Storage Facility at 330 Business Parkway.

- Adopted Res. 22-09 approved site plan modification, special exception use and architectural approval for a restaurant with drive-thru (Starbucks) at 11001 Southern Blvd. at Southern Palm Crossing Shopping Center.
- Approved first reading of Ordinance No. 1026 amending Chapter 26 to include Senior Housing Facility as a special exception use in the Industrial General Zoning district.
- Approved first reading of Ordinance No. 1029 amending Chapter 6 -Buildings and Building Regulations adding a new Division 4 for Landlord Tenant Notice Requirements and Notice of Termination Requirements and Written Notification Requirements related to rental payment increases and 60-days written notice for termination of tenancies and increases in rental rates.
- Annual review and approval of 5% merit for the Village Manager
