Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, and if it may be affected by local drainage problems, or is in an area that has previously had flooding problems, and to see if your property is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property.

- Approved budget amendment in Fund 301 FY21/22 Budget to transfer \$196,000.00 from Undesignated Fund Balance to Commons Park Pathway Lighting.
- Approved bid of \$960,000 to Gerelco Traffic Controls, Inc. for Commons Park Pathway Lighting.
- Approved Change Order #5 for License Plate Reader Camera Installation with Broadcast Systems for \$92,010.18.
- Approved College Tuition Reimbursement for part time employees.
- Approved Change Order with Nex Era Services for Roadway Grounds Maintenance Service to modify Scope of Work in the amount of \$72,375.80.

- Adopted Res. 21-22 to execute Florida Memorandum of Understanding for settlements obtained related to the Opioid Litigation.
- Approved conveyance of Villageowned property to Paint Lux, LLC and Keiser University.
- Adopted Ord. 1020 amending Chapter 9. Fences, hedges and walls. to add exemption to the permit requirement for fence repairs at 25% and revise existing regulations to require certain fences to be constructed with finished side to adjoining lot or right-of-way.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 1023 amending the Comprehensive Development Plan with mandates set forth in Section 163.3184 to add and adopt private property rights element.
- Appointed Denise Lawrence to a regular seat and Jennifer Sullivan to an Alternate seat on the Education Advisory Board.
