Council Regular Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, December 19, 2019 The following action was taken:

- Adopted Res. 19-38 adopting a revised Schedule of Fees & Charges repealing Res. 19-26.
- Adopted Res. 19-35 supporting the prohibition of underage drinking and encouraging retailers, vendors and other providers of alcohol to voluntarily post signs detailing the prohibition of and penalties related to underage drinking.
- Adopted Res. 19-36 amending the Pension Plan to provide for an update to those provisions of the Plan that regulate the composition of the membership.
- Approved Foreclosure Registry
   Services Agreement with ProChamps
   piggybacking Clay County Agreement
   dated June 25, 2019.
- Denied authorization to purchase 180 Sandpiper Avenue.
- Presentation and Approval of Professional Services Agreement and Consultant Services Authorization No. 1 with REG Architects, Inc. for Village Hall Architectural & Engineering Design Services. The cost not to exceed \$448,139.00.
- Approved application by Lennar Homes, LLC for a MCIC to allow for an amended phasing plan regarding the timing for the PUD recreation site located at Crestwood Blvd.
- Approved Preliminary Plat for 156.258± acre parcel located on the south side of Southern Blvd. approximately 0.27 miles west of State Road 7.

- Approved Master Plan and Special Exception for PCD located on the south side of Southern Blvd. approximately 0.27 miles west of State Road 7.
- Approved Site Plan, Special Exception and Architectural for a 77,674 square foot "Public and Private Academic Institution (Charter School) on 10.174± located on the west side of 106th Avenue South, south of Acme Road.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 999
  modifying Chapter 22 Subdivision of
  Land, the requirements for Park and
  Recreation Land Dedication or
  payment of fees in lieu thereof.
- Approved first reading of Ord. 1000 modifying Chapter 26—Zoning, the requirements for Park and Recreation Land Dedication or payment of fees in lieu thereof.
- Adopted Ord. 993 Right-of-way Regulations to conform this article to recent state law changes regarding communications facilities, especially wireless facilities in Villages rights-of way.
- Appointed Lynda Walker to the Pension Plan Board.


