Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's
Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103
for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate
Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a
property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area,
and if it may be affected by local drainage
problems, or is in an area that has previously
had flooding problems, and to see if your
property is located near an area that should
be protected because of its natural floodplain
functions. Village staff is available to provide
property protection consultations including
site visits and drainage evaluations on your
property.

Virtual Council Regular Meeting was called to order Thursday, December 17, 2020

The following action was taken:

- Approved purchase of 4 vehicles from Duval Ford not to exceed \$144,938.00 and by piggybacking the Florida Sheriffs Association Light Vehicle Contract FSA20-VEL28.0. Heavy equipment and trucks FSA20-VEH 18.0.
- Approved bid award to Professional Concessions, Inc. to provide alcoholic beverage sales in Commons Park.
- Approved First Addendum to the Professional Services Agreement for Urban Forestry Service to extend agreement until January 1, 2022.
- Approved Special Event Permits for the Village to hold Concert and Movie Night and Gourmet Truck Expos at Royal Palm Beach Commons Park every Friday night beginning January 2021 through April 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- Approved budget amendment for Fund 303 in the FY 2020/2021 Budget to transfer \$36,000 from Equipment Replacement (PW2001) to Okeechobee Lighting Replacement (PW2108).
- Adopted Ord. 1009 amending Chapter 24 Utilities adding language allowing exemption from the imposition of the stormwater utility fee.
