Legislative Bill Summaries

Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, and if it may be affected by local drainage problems, or is in an area that has previously had flooding problems, and to see if your property is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property.

- Approved a Special Event Permit for YBARPB to hold a Baseball Tournament at Bob Marcello Park from Dec. 9 through Dec. 11.
- Approved a Special Event Permit for American Cancer Society to hold a fundraiser at Commons Park on February 25th from 4:00 p.m.-9:30 p.m.
- Approved a budget amendment for Fund 303 to transfer \$16,000 from Artificial Turf Safety Surface to Playscape Replacement.

- Approved a budget amendment for Fund 408 to transfer \$37,500 from Undesignated Fund Balance, appropriate \$112,500 from a new Federal FEMA grant and create a new Watershed Management Plan project.

- Approved first reading of Ord. 1027 to add a new section for MXS Mixed Use Social Center to establish sign regulations and recreation requirements for Mixed Use Social Center developments.
