<u>Council Regular Meeting</u> was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Thursday, February 20, 2020 The following action was taken:

- Approved Second Addendum to the Communication Plan Professional Service Agreement with My PR Guru.
- Approved budget amendment for Fund 001 in FY 19/20 budget to transfer \$20,000 from Other Contractual Services to Salaries and Wages and create a new Custodial Position.
- Approved budget amendment for Fund 303 in FY 19/20 budget to transfer \$23,000 from Recreation Center Painting to Sporting Center Improvements.

- Approved a Special Event Permit for H.L. Johnson Elementary PTO, Inc. to hold a Spring Carnival style fundraiser event at 1000 Crestwood Blvd. on Saturday, March 7th from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Approved Traffic Control Jurisdiction Agreement between the Village and Bella Terra Community Association, Inc.

- Bid award and contract approval in an amount of \$212,762.00 to Davco Electrical Contractors Corp. for the removal and replacement of sports lighting at Bob Marcello Park.
- Approved Sports Lighting Equipment and Services Agreement with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC for Bob Marcello Park. The cost shall not exceed \$351,200.00.
