Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, and if it may be affected by local drainage problems, or is in an area that has previously had flooding problems, and to see if your property is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property.
