Legislative Bill Summaries

Know Your Flood Zone

Call the Village of Royal Palm Beach's Engineering Department at (561) 790-5103 for access to FEMA's Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) for our village, and to learn if a property is in a Special Flood Hazard Area, and if it may be affected by local drainage problems, or is in an area that has previously had flooding problems, and to see if your property is located near an area that should be protected because of its natural floodplain functions. Village staff is available to provide property protection consultations including site visits and drainage evaluations on your property.

- Approved Special Event Permit for PBSO Family First Kickball Fundraiser at Bob Marcello Park on Sat., Jan. 29, 2022 at 7:00 a.m.
- Approved Special Event Permit for Barky Pines Animal Rescue & Sanctuary, Inc. to hold a 5K run/ walk at Commons Park, Saturday, February 12, 2022 at 7:00 a.m.
- Approved CSA No. 8 with REG Architects, Inc. to provide Construction Administration for the Village Hall Construction not to exceed \$93,800.00
- Approved budget amendment for Fund 301 in FY21/22 to transfer \$180,000 from Undesignated Fund Balance to Commons Park Pathway Lighting
- Approved bid award of \$757,764.00 for Commons Park Pathway Lighting project to National Traffic Control Systems, Inc.

- Approved American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Agreement
- Approved a one-time \$500 vaccination incentive and a one-time \$1,000 Premium Pay to eligible employees who worked through COVID-19 pandemic
- Approved the 2022 Municipal Election Vote Processing Equipment Use and Elections Services Agreement with PBC Supervisor of Elections
- Approved agreement with Haverland AG Innovations, Inc. for 4 multipurpose athletic fields at Seminole Palms Park not to exceed \$70,000
- Approved bid award to Eats & Teas Holding, LLC for a monthly lease of \$500 in Commons Park Sporting Center
- Approved Site Plan, architectural approval and special exception use for a Raising Cane's Restaurant with drivethrough.
- Postponed second reading of Ord. 1014 amending Chapter 20—Signs and create definitions for select terms related to sign identification and regulations and to conform to recent legal precedent regarding signs and internal consistency until November 18, 2021
- Approved first reading of Ord. 1021 amending Chapter 11. Fire Prevention and Protection., Section 11-23 Propane Storage in order to better conform with industry standards relative to tank sizes.
