was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Thursday, September 17, 2020

The following action was taken:

- Announced proposed operating millage rate to fund budget is 4.97% above the rolled-back rate of 1.8291mils.
- Announced proposed operating millage rate is 1.9200 for the General Fund.
- Adopted Res. 20-19 and final millage rate of 1.9200 for FY2020/2021.
- Adopted Res. 20-20 and final Budget for FY2020/2021.

Thursday, September 17, 2020

The following action was taken:

- Approved an addendum to extend Traffic Calming Policy Development Services provided by Simmons and White for 2 years
- Adopted Res. 20-21 and Local Agency Program Agreement with FDOT for the construction of Pedestrian Lighting along FPL pathway from LaMancha Ave. south to approx. 1,000 feet north of Lamstein Lane
- Adopted Res. 20-22. Schedule of Fees and Charges
- Approved bid award to Horizon A/C, Inc. in the amount of \$45,076.00 for monthly maintenance and \$38,245.00 for scheduled replacement units
- Approved Special Event Permit for the Village to hold Concert and Moving Night and Gourmet Truck Expos at Commons Park every Friday night beginning October 2, 2020 through December 18, 2020 alternating between concerts and movies each week

- Approved Special Event Permit for the Village to hold Green Market and Bazaar at Village Hall every Saturday, beginning October 10, 2020 through April 30, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Adopted Ord. 1005 amending Chapter 17. Offenses and Misc. Provisions. Public Parks—in order to modify the hours of operation for public parks within the Village
- Approved first reading of Ord. 1006 amending Chapter 17 Offenses and Misc. Provisions and add a new section Palm Beach County Solicitation and Distribution on Public Roads Ordinance to apply to all public roads within the Village's boundaries that are open to motor vehicle traffic
- Appointed Alternate Adam Miller to a regular seat on the P & Z Commission and appointed Lauren McClellan to Alternate Seat #1 and Gerald Brown to Alternate Seat #2
