Recreation Center Expansion & Remodeling Project

Budget : \$15+mil

Budget Year: FY 2024

Update: The project will provide an additional 30,000sq.ft. of programming space and a completely renovate the existing 30,000sq.ft. of the current Recreation Center. The project also includes improvements to the parking lots and a connection to the Katz Soccer Fields Complex.

Tentative Schedule : **Phase 1 is Under Contract, April 2025**

Cultural Center Entry Enhancement

Budget : \$400,000

Budget Year: FY 2024

Update: The project will provide overhead weather protection for guest arriving and leaving the Cultural Center.

Tentative Schedule : **Under Contract, work to begin May 2025**

Bob Marcello Lighting Upgrade

Budget : \$600,000

Budget Year: FY 2025

Update: LED light replacement for park areas including Fields #1, #4, Basketball Court, Batting Cages

Tentative Schedule : **Contract to be awarded at May 15th Village Council Meeting.**

Frisbee Golf Pads – Commons Park

Budget: \$17,000

Budget Year: FY 2025

Update: This project will enhance the course with 2 tee-pads for each hole.

Tentative Schedule : **On schedule for May 2025 installations.**

All Access Playground – Commons Park

Budget: \$650,000

Budget Year: FY 2025

Update: This project will enhance the surface of the existing north play set and build a new adjacent pay-set that is targeted to user with physical and sensory disabilities

Tentative Schedule : July-September 2025

Artificial Turf - Katz Soccer Field

Budget : \$3,500,000

Budget Year: FY 2026

Update: This project has be re-submitted for a LWCF Grant (\$1.5mil) with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection-Division of State Lands

Tentative Schedule : TBD, based upon LWCF Grant award timeline.
