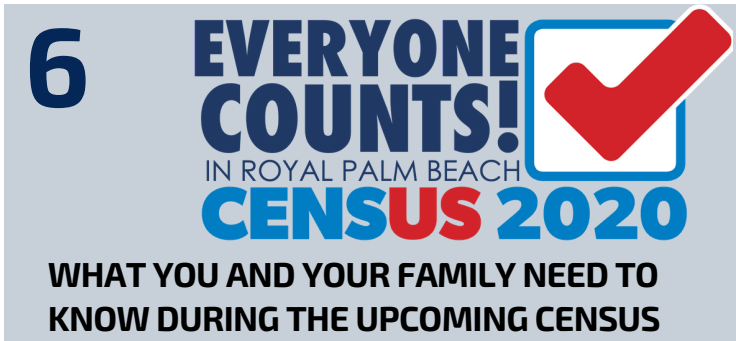

## VILLAGE STEPS UP TO HELP SENIORS STEP OUT

Royal Palm Beach is addressing one of the most common problems facing the Village's senior residents.

Experts say more than half of all non-drivers 65 and older stay at home because they don't have transportation options. This leads to seniors skipping medical appointments, becoming isolated, and losing independence.

A special Village of Royal Palm Beach program is helping seniors get out and around. The program, offered by the Recreation Department, teaches seniors how to set up and use a ride share account on a smart phone. Once they have successfully completed the class, the Village gives them a \$35 ride share gift card to get them started.

The class is offered on the first Tuesday of the month. It is open to village residents with proof of address. Gift cards are limited to one per year. Call 790-5124 for more information.

## NEW VILLAGE HALL WILL IMPROVE RESIDENT SERVICES AND SAFETY

With plans moving forward on the design and construction of a new Village Hall, one of the project's top priorities is to create a destination offering increased levels of service and safety.

Members of the Village Council and staff are working with architects to create a one-stop shop for all resident services. It will be more environmentally efficient and possibly have a smaller footprint than the current building, allowing for more open space in the Village Hall complex.

Discussions on expanding Village Hall date back to 2011 when staff first looked to add on to the existing building. But expansions would not have solved the problem of a lack of a hurricane-rated building from which to operate during a storm.

The design process will include opportunities for members of the community to weigh in on needs and designs. Construction is expected to begin in 2021.

# BUILDING PARTNERSHIPS BETWEEN ROYAL PALM BEACH'S YOUTH, LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND THE COMMUNITY

Royal Palm Beach is home to a unique program for kids between 11 and 17 years of age looking to get in shape and learn how to defend themselves. It is the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Police Athletic League Boxing Program.

The Police Athletic League is a youth crime prevention program that relies on educational, athletic and other recreational activities to cement a bond and create trust and understanding between law enforcement and youth.

The PBSO District 9 Substation in Royal Palm Beach is where the boxing program is located. It is open Monday through Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The gym is in the David Farber Training Building directly next to Village Hall.

Students are always invited to visit and see if they would like to attend. All required equipment is free. If someone does not want to spar, they can still attend, learn the techniques, and get in shape.

The program is completely flexible with a student's schedule. They can attend 1 day or 5 days, 1 hour or 4 hours a day. Anyone can participate as much or as little as they would like.

**If everyone in RPB is counted, it  
means millions for our village**

In a single year, the Village of Royal Palm Beach collects approximately \$5 million dollars of your property taxes. If everyone in the Village is counted during the 2020 Census, the Village could receive three times that amount in additional federal dollars.

The census provides critical data that is used to provide daily services, products, and support for Royal Palm Beach residents. Every year, billions of dollars in federal funding go to hospitals, fire departments, schools, roads, and other resources based on census data. A complete and accurate count is critical for our village because the results of the 2020 Census will affect community funding, congressional representation, and more.



In mid-March, Royal Palm Beach residents will begin receiving invitations to complete the 2020 Census. Once the invitation arrives, you should respond for your home in one of three ways: online, by phone, or by mail.

You should count everyone living in your home. This includes:

- All children
- All citizens and non-citizens
- All legal and illegal residents

The Census Bureau cannot release any identifiable information about you, your home, or your business, even to law enforcement agencies.

The law ensures that your private data is protected and that your answers cannot be used against you by any government agency or court.

You are kept anonymous. The Census Bureau is not permitted to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or anyone else in your home.

# Message from the Young at Heart President



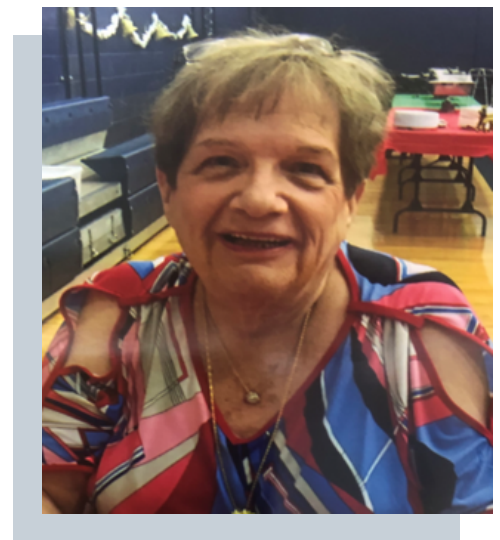

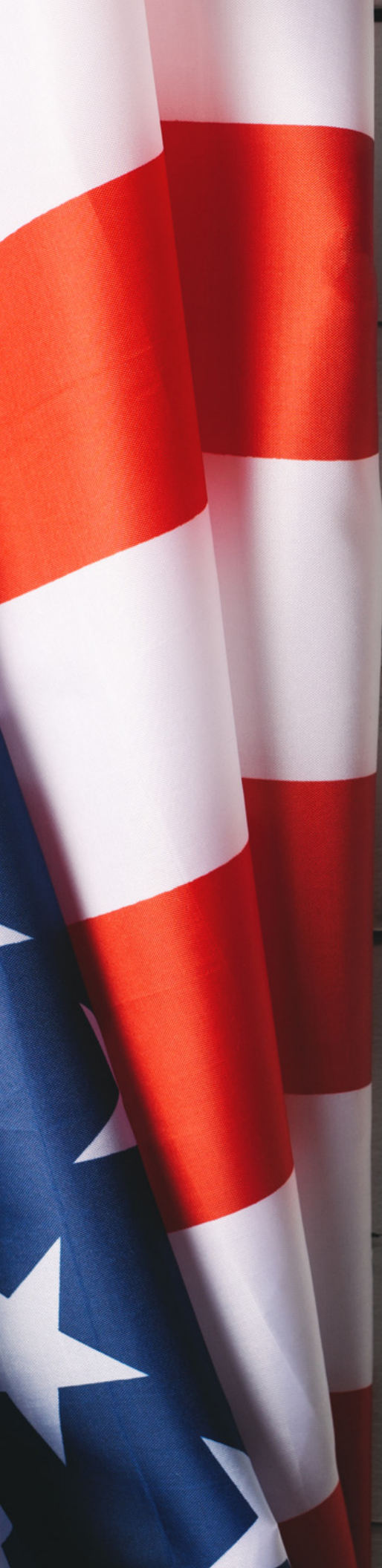

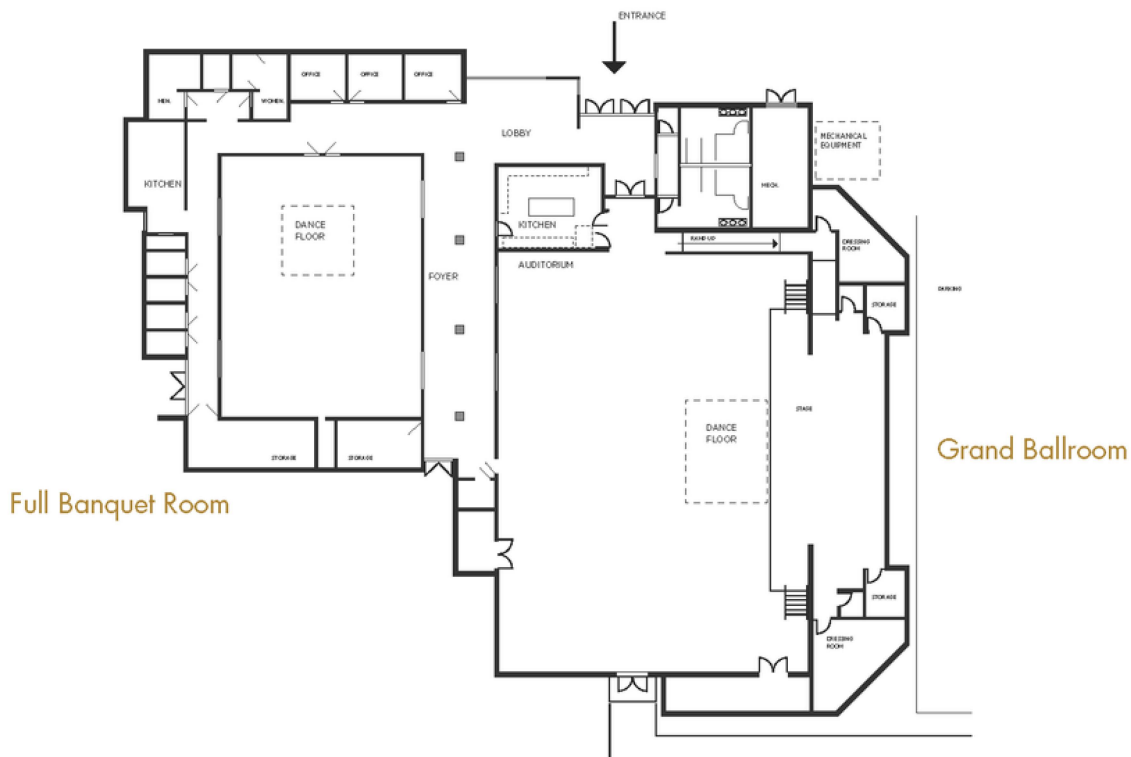
