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INTRODUCTION

This directory was undertaken to assist the Village of Royal Palm Beach and its senior population to ascertain what kinds of services were available to them within a 5-10 mile radius. The information herein should not be interpreted as an endorsement of any kind. This directory is meant to be:

- Ever changing due to market fluctuations
- Not a static directory as Agency names phone numbers and addresses change, as does the funding for the services outlined
- A guide to types of services that the typical Senior, living in Royal Palm Beach may need now or in the future
- Not an all-encompassing listing of all services and service and/or health organizations
- The Directory itself will need to be updated, at regular intervals
- Descriptions of agencies and services were meant to be short and to the point; expanded descriptions can be found elsewhere, i.e. the internet, other published documents or by contacting the organizations themselves

It must be noted that many agencies and service organizations offer a multitude of services. We have tried to capture the main areas of service provision.

HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY

This directory has been divided up into two distinct sections. The first section of this directory is a Listing by Service that has specific services enumerated including the agencies offering those services. An agency may be listed under a number of categories, as an example, "Informational Services" and "Referral Services." Many agencies in this directory offer multiple types of services in order to assist the senior population in Palm Beach County as a whole and Royal Palm Beach specifically.
