#### Agenda Item:

APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR OUR LADY QUEEN OF THE APOSTLES CATHOLIC CHURCH TO HOLD ITS A CHRISTMAS FESTIVAL AND VILLAGE AT 100 CRESTWOOD BOULEVARD ON DECEMBER 6, 2019, DECEMBER 7, 2019 DECEMBER 8, 2019 DECEMBER 13, 2019 DECEMBER 14, 2019 AND DECEMBER 15, 2019; BY JIM DUEMIG.

#### Issue:

The applicant is requesting a special event permit in order to hold a Christmas Festival and Village at Our Lady Queen of the Apostles Catholic Church, located at 100 Crestwood Boulevard on the following dates and times: Friday December 6, 20019 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., Friday December 13, 2019 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Saturday, December 7, 2019, from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.; Saturday, December 14, 2019 from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.; and Sunday, December 8, 2019 from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The applicant has not requested any road closures for this event. The Church is requesting a special no fee permit for non-profit organizations. The applicant has submitted all necessary information and forms to the Village. Staff has reviewed this application and determined that the proposed use will not adversely affect the immediate area.

#### **EXHIBIT A**

- 1. The event may only occur on Friday December 6, 20019 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., Friday December 13, 2019 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Saturday, December 7, 2019, from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.; Saturday, December 14, 2019 from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; and Sunday, December 8, 2018 from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Sunday, December 15, 2019 from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 2. Any tents used shall be flame resistant.
- 3. A Business Tax Receipt is required and permits must be obtained for all temporary electrical services, generators or temporary power poles and must be inspected prior to commencement of sales.
- 4. All electrical circuits shall be GFI protected.
- 5. Signage shall be set back at least 10 feet from the property line and shall not interfere with sight lines along public roadways and shall conform to the requirements of Sec. 20-71 of the Village Code of Ordinances.
- 6. A clearly defined paved parking area must be provided.
- 7. The applicant shall provide for portable restroom facilities including at least one handicapped accessible facility if public facilities are not within 500' of accessibility.
- 8. Adequate trash receptacles shall be provided for tree trimming and other debris, which may accumulate on site.
- 9. If trailer is to be used on site for security purpose, the applicant shall obtain temporary trailer permit from the Village Building Department. This trailer may trailer permit from the Village Building Department. This trailer may not be used for overnight sleeping purposes.
- 10. No parking will be allowed in the swales of Crestwood Boulevard.
- 11. Adequate provision shall be made for overflow parking
- 12. The applicant shall be responsible for traffic safety, and shall coordinate traffic control with the Palm Beach County Sherriff, if the need arises.

adjacent properties and will not be detrimental to their use and peaceful enjoyment of their property?
Hasn't been an issue in the past. Entertainment
stages will be faced away from residential area and all outdoor entertainment will cease at 11:00 PM.
at the latest. **Rides will be replaced with Christmas Village**

C. How will you assure that the proposed special event will not cause objectionable noise, vibrations, fumes, odors, glare or physical activity which cannot be prevented by the imposition of conditions?

Again same as "B" far as noise. (This has never been an issue for our past Festivals.

Although there will be entertainment this will be focused away from residential areas.

Our trash container will be away from residential area and odor not an issue.

D. How is the proposed special event compatible with the character of the location for which it is proposed?

This event is the church's largest fund raiser of the year and besides raising the funds necessary to operate the church, it's

also a great fellowship event for our parishioners and neighbors alike.
