APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR VILLAGE OF ROYAL PALM BEACH TO CONDUCT A SHAKESPEARE FESTIVAL AT ROYAL PALM BEACH COMMONS PARK ON THURSDAY, AUGUST 19TH, 2021 THROUGH SUNDAY AUGUST 22nd, 2021; AND THURSDAY, AUGUST 26TH 2021; THROUGH AUGUST 29TH, 2021 FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M.; BY SYLVIO PIERRE-LOUIS.

Issue:

The applicant is requesting approval to allow a special event permit in order to hold Shakespeare Festival at Commons Park. The event is proposed to take place on Thursday, August 19th, 2021 through Sunday, August 22nd, 2021; and Thursday, August 26th, 2021 through August 29^{th, 2021} from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The Village is properly insured for such events.

EXHIBIT A

- All special event activities approved as part of this permit shall be governed by current public health directives and shall comply with all Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines and all Executive Orders issued by the Governor relative to COVID-19.
- 2. The event may only occur on Thursday, August 19th, 2021 through Sunday, August 22nd, 2021 and Thursday, August 26th, 2021; through Sunday, August 29th, 2021 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- 3. Any tents used shall be flame resistant.
- 4. A Business Tax Receipt is required and permits must be obtained for all temporary electrical services, generators or temporary power poles and must be inspected prior to commencement of sales.
- 5. All electrical circuits shall be GFI protected.
- 6. Signage shall be set back at least 10 feet from the property line and shall not interfere with sight lines along public roadways and shall conform to the requirements of Sec. 20-71(Temporary Special Event Signs) of the Village Code of Ordinances.
- 7. A clearly defined paved parking area must be provided.
- 8. The applicant shall provide for portable restroom facilities including at least one handicapped accessible facility if public facilities are not within 500' of accessibility.
- 9. Adequate trash receptacles shall be provided for debris, which may accumulate on site.
