

**ROYAL PALM BEACH EDUCATION ADVISORY BOARD
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR**

The Village of Royal Palm Beach offers eleven (11) \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors residing in the Village of Royal Palm Beach. Applicants should have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. (verified by guidance counselor signature) and have been actively engaged in both the school and local communities. Scholarships can be used at the discretion of the winners towards any post-secondary advancement opportunity (including college, university, or trade school costs). A minimum of four (4) scholarships will be awarded to Royal Palm Beach High School seniors residing in the Village.

CRITERIA

1. Applications downloaded are preferred at www.royalpalmbeachfl.gov. Typewritten applications must follow the document's format. Only typewritten applications will be accepted.
2. All applications must be signed by the applicant, the principal and the guidance counselor.
3. All completed applications must be postmarked or emailed no later than February 20, 2026, or submitted to the Clerk's Office in Village Hall by 5:00 p.m. on February 20, 2026. JDavy@royalpalmbeachfl.gov
4. No attachments. Any attachments will be reason for disqualification.
5. Finalists must be available for interviews on Saturday, April 18, 2026 (no attachments, clippings, portfolios will be allowed at interviews).

Winners will be notified by mail/email. Public announcement of winners will be announced in May. Scholarships will be presented at the Village Council meeting on May 21, 2026.
